Neighborhood Initiative Summer Job Program

DEERFIELD BEACH, FL – The Neighborhood Initiative Summer Job Program hereby announces the opening of the application process for summer 2017.

The objective of the summer program is to provide employment opportunities and mentorship to meet the needs of at-risk youth between the ages of 13-15 years old.

Application(s) may be picked up Monday, May 1st through Friday, May 12th at the Oveta McKeithen Recreational Complex, located at 445 SW 2nd St, between the hours of 9:00am – 9:00pm. The completed application and a letter of recommendation must be returned no later than Friday, May 12th by 9:00pm to the Oveta McKeithen Recreational Complex. Please note that there are limited opportunities available.

Interviews will be conducted on Tuesday, May 16th and Wednesday, May 17th from 4:00pm – 7:00pm. The interviews will be conducted on the 2nd floor of the Concession Stand Building at Oveta McKeithen Recreational Complex (151 SW 3rd Ave.) All applicants are required to dress professionally.

The Neighborhood Initiative Program is an eight-week summer employment opportunity that will commence on Monday, June 12th and conclude on Friday, August 4th for the students selected for employment. There will be required weekly program meetings conducted on Mondays. The student employees will be assigned to various businesses in Deerfield Beach working three days per week.

Requirements for the NIP Summer Job Program

- Applicants must be between the ages of 13 - 15 years old from May 1 – August 4, 2017.
- A copy of Birth Certificate must be presented for proof of age.
- Applicants must be City of Deerfield Beach residents.
- Two proofs of City of Deerfield Beach residency are required.
- Applicants must obtain a letter of recommendation from one of the following: Guidance Counselor, Teacher, Principal / Assistant Principal or Other Professional. The letter must state that the student is considered at risk and the reason why they should be considered for employment with the Neighborhood Initiative Summer Job Program.
