QUALIFICATIONS

Deerfield Beach High School 2023-2024 Parking Registration Form

To qualify for a parking tag a student must:

- 1. Have a valid operator driver's license. Permits are NOT valid.
- 2. Proof of legal vehicle insurance.
- 3. Complete a parking application in full including having this form notarized.
- 4. Must be enrolled in grades 10-12,
- 5. Have a 2.0 GPA or higher.
- 6. Be cleared of all school obligations from the previous school year(s).
- 7. Pay a \$60 fee ONLINE ONLY

PARKING PERMIT REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES

- 1. Parking permits will be sold on a "First Come-First Serve" basis. Once all spaces are filled, no permits will be sold.
- 2. Once issued, parking permits cannot be altered or transferred to another student's vehicle.
- 3. Parking Decals must be displayed and visible on the rear view mirror at all times while on campus.
- 4. Loitering in the parking lot is not permitted. After entering the parking area, all students must leave their cars immediately and report to their designated area, and remain on campus.
- 5. Cars are not to be used as lockers. Students should return to their cars only when leaving school at the end of the day or after signing out at the Star System.
- 6. Student parking is in designated areas only. There is no parking on the grass, faculty/staff areas, or in visitor parking.
- 7. Parking tags will be revoked if removed from vehicles for any reason other than surrendering it to school administration.
- 8. School Board Policy 5307... "The Board of Public Instruction shall not be responsible for damage to automobiles or other vehicles which are parked or operated on school property."
- 9. A parking Permit MUST be purchased if a parking permit is lost or stolen. This includes students changing automobiles during the school year.
- 10. Students may receive a parking permit application in Student Affairs or online at www.DeerfieldBeachHigh.net

PARKING PERMT CIATION/SUSPENSION/REVOCATION MAY OCCUR IF:

- 1. A student fails to register a vehicle with administration
- 2. A student has unauthorized absences from campus, leaves campus and/or takes other students off campus without permission
- 3. A student exceeds the 5mph speed limit in the parking area.
- 4. A student transfers, sells or receives a legal, illegal or fraudulent parking permit.
- 5. A student parks in unauthorized areas.
- 6. A student engages in reckless driving and/or speeding in the parking lot or within the perimeter of the school grounds.
- 7. A student's vehicle displaying words or graphics that are in poor taste and/or create a disruption of the school process.
- 8. A student has excessive tardies or absences from school.
- 9. A student is in the parking area without a proper pass.
- 10. A student does not have a current signed Student Code of Conduct form on file in Student Affairs.
